What Martial Art Is Taught?

CAMA stresses Korean martial arts, particularly Hapkido. The guiding principle behind any of our teaching is not only the Fruit of the Spirit, but also following the "Golden Rule" - Do unto others as you would have them do unto you. With this motto in our teaching, and remembering to be a complete person, a complete martial artist, a person must be receptive to change and gaining knowledge from reputable sources. The focus is not on the art, but on the journey of the individual learning the art and more importantly, finding a closer relationship to Christ while gaining a solid understanding of self-defense techniques.

Our students are also taught and encouraged to uphold Christian values such as:

"Where is the balance" (It's deciding what's important, not urgent)

"He doesn't call the equipped, He equips the called..."

"Add to your faith..." (II Peter 1:5 – 9)

"Ask God to bless everyone..." (Romans 12:14 – 18)
